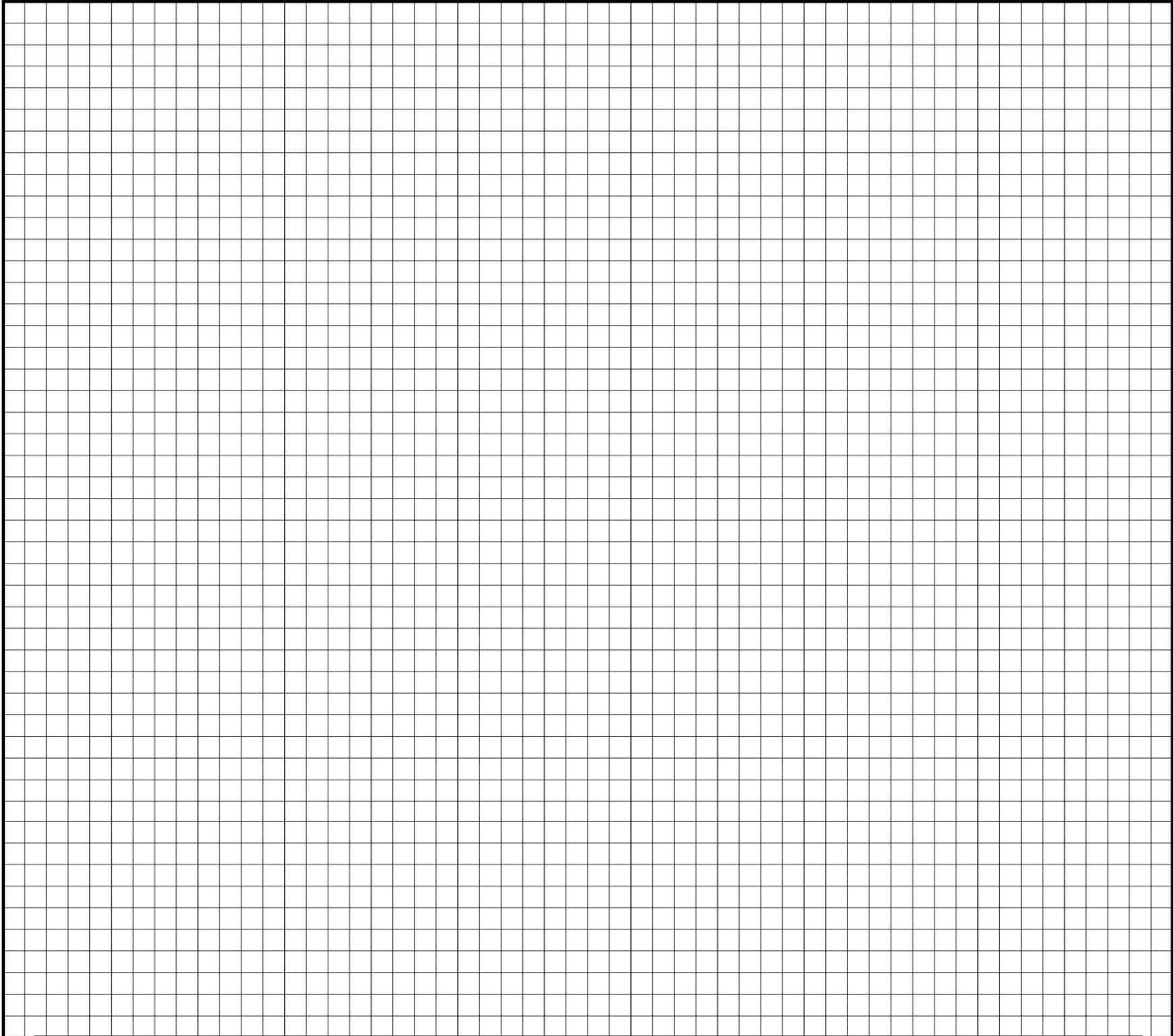

Firstly, draw an outline of your area on the ALW downloadable PDF measuring sheet. 2 boxes equal 1 metre ie 1:100.

Please take as many measurements as possible, you can never get too many measurements, our objective is to minimise any waste or unnecessary offcuts.

Synthetic lawn has a 'one direction pile' meaning it must be laid and joined in the same direction to avoid unpleasant looking joins.

**Ensure you measure...**

- All straight edges (show all measurements on plan)
- Longest and widest points (show over-all measurements on plan)
- Shortest and narrowest points (show overall measurements on plan)

Mark as many areas on the plan that do not have a hard edge to butt up to, ie no paving, concrete paths or curbing for the lawn to butt up to – Draw these in a broken line.

**Also mark...**

- Any trees
  - Water meters
  - Garden or flower beds that are going to remain
  - Sloping areas
- ...anything else that may be an obstruction or you feel may affect the laying
